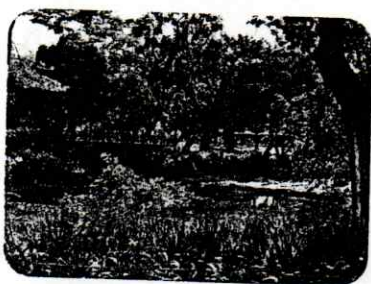

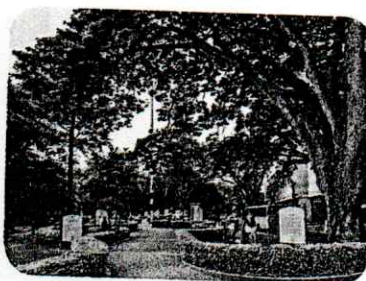
Colombian Green Area Leaflet

- The expression "There are" is used with plural countable nouns.
 - There are lots of small neighbourhood parks.
